


A Summer Message from your Pastor ...

Michael's current offering report only covers the first <u>three</u> weeks of May since we are meeting a week early. General Fund - \$12,607.91; Capital Fund - \$793.04; Good Samaritan Fund - \$783.00; and LWR Baby Care - \$879.00.

Connie will set up the display for our June emphasis which is Midwest Shelter for Homeless Vets (MSHV) this coming weekend. Karol will write the article for the July emphasis which is our Worship/Altar guild committee.

We are still in need of donors for the June 6<sup>th</sup> blood drive. We currently have 10 donors signed up with a possibility of 4-5 walk-ins. Lynn will work the 2:30-5:00 shift and Mark will cover the 5:00-7:00 shift.

There are 4 quilts going to the Lutherdale Quilt auction. They need to be there by July 15<sup>th</sup>. The quilts will be displayed in the Fellowship Hall for viewing probably in late June or July.

We will have Pastor Dennis Heaney with us on June 15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> and Pastor Tom Rogers on June 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, and again on June 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> when Pastor Chris will be gone.

Our next scheduled meeting is on Wed., July  $3^{\rm rd}$  at 8:45 a.m. We adjourned at 9:25 by praying The Lord's Prayer.






