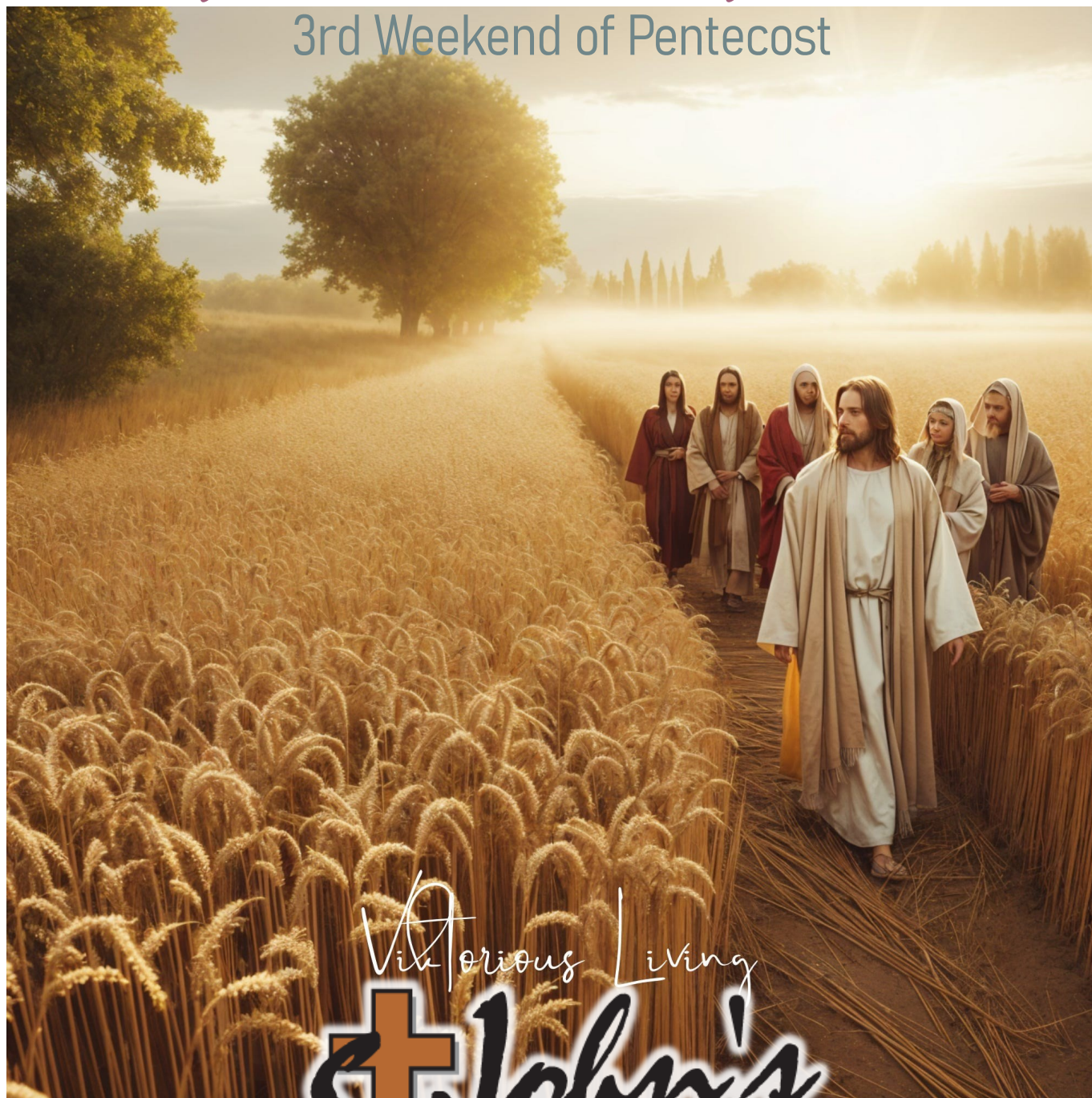

Apostle's Creed
